ESOTERIC FREEMASONRY

In July, WB Shane Crabtree delivered a paper for Masonic Education entitled, *A Guide For The New Esoteric Freemason*. For those of you who missed it, it stated, "This paper presents a viewpoint which supports that esotericism is a legitimate element of the Craft and exists by design, and that Freemasonry is the inheritor of a great wealth of secret knowledge which has been encoded in rituals, symbols, and traditions." It also argues that many Blue Lodges are not equipped to mentor those new Masons who express an interest in the esoteric aspect of our ritual, even though Masonic Ritual is ripe with evidence to the contrary. Brother Robert G. Davis eloquently echoed this sentiment when he wrote:

"We all know Masons who believe with all their heart there is nothing spiritual about the rituals of Masonry. There are those who claim there is nothing to learn beyond the ritual words. There are even more who are appalled when it is suggested that Kabalistic, Alchemical, or Hermetic associations might be made from a study of the Degrees of Masonry. Never mind that every aspirant is told before he receives the very first Degree that Masonry is a course of hieroglyphic instruction taught by allegories."

So the question begs, how do you teach the esoteric aspect of Freemasonry? Like the rest of Freemasonry, candidates can only be shown the door. After that, each individual must seek enlightenment on their own terms. What may be a relevant lesson to some may not apply to others. With this in mind, Esoteric Freemasonry is not for everyone. There are some who choose not to pursue the esoteric path and there are others who claim that there simply is no esoteric content at all to be had in Freemasonry.

There is no right or wrong view on this (See the proper way to wear a Masonic Ring). Freemasonry means something different to everyone. Each Brother must go in search of his own path of enlightenment and determine what is right for him. It's not up to us to lead a Brother in a course we feel is the most important or relevant. But rather, we should provide guidance from the knowledge that we possess.

As many of you have seen, we have quite a few new Brothers as well as many candidates. Most of them are showing an interest in the esoteric aspect of Freemasonry and are actively seeking mentoring. For those of you who have a wealth of knowledge in this area, I would invite you to get to know these Brothers and offer your guidance and help them find what they are pursuing

From the Secretary's

Desk

Judging from all the signage on every street corner, we are aware this is another election year for various offices.....and the question arises as to what are the duties of these elected officials? We are fortunate that Freemasonrys' officers' duties are easily spelled out, i.e. Worshipful Master, etc.:



Worshipful Master: He sits in the east, symbolic of the rising sun, and presides over the lodge, like a president or chairman. During his term as Master, his word is final over the actions of the lodge; he presides over business meetings and the conferral of degrees. He is also responsible, as the ritual instructs, for "setting the Craft to work and giving them good and wholesome instruction for their labor." Even if the lodge building faces the wrong direction, the Master is said to be "in the east". The Master's jewel of office is the right angle of a square, a stonemason's tool used for checking the angles of cut and smoothed stones. It is not a measuring square, like carpenters use, it is used to make certain an angle is "true". It symbolizes virtue.

Masons call the man in charge of the lodge "Worshipful Master", but that does not mean they "worship" him. This is a term of honor, from the original intent of the word, meaning, "to give respect".



Senior Warden: The Senior Warden sits in the west, symbolic of the setting sun, and assists the Worshipful Master in opening and closing the lodge. He is also the second in command, like the vice president, and if the Master is unable to attend the meeting, he may open and conduct business. His ancient duties were to pay the Craft their wages, and to handle disputes among the workers. These days he's just a heartbeat away from the east, so his task is to support the Master and to prepare himself for that office for the following year.

The Senior Warden's jewel of office is the level, a stonemason's instrument used to check the level of horizontal surfaces. It symbolizes that all Masons meet on the level, without regard to social, political, or religious status.

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Trowel-Talk #41 by Brother Tom Lyle, PVST#29

Question: Did Albert Pike give us a formula for Masonic success?

My brothers, a frequent complaint about Pike's Masonically-magnificent book "Morals & Dogma" is that it is much too difficult to read. Some say it is his literary references which he obviously was intimately familiar with and which is, for the most part, not included in our modern education. Although this is quite true, there may be another very significant reason: we tend to read it like a novel and that just doesn't work for clarity of understanding. It is like putting fifty pounds into a five pound bag. Perhaps a slowing down and a focusing can allow his light to shine through, and thereby assist good men striving to become better men. Let us give Pike an opportunity to answer to our question: did he give us a formula for Masonic success, (and if so what is it?)

"The Will is a force; its limits as yet unknown. It is in the power of the will that we chiefly see the spiritual and divine in man. There is a seeming identity between his will that moves other men, and the Creative Will whose action seems so incomprehensible. It is the men of will and action, not the men of pure intellect, that govern the world." ¹

"Morality is a force. It is the magnetic attraction of the heart towards Truth and Virtue." ²

"Finally, the three greatest moral forces are FAITH, which is the only true WISDOM, and the very foundation of all government; HOPE, which is STRENGTH, and assures success; and CHARITY, which is BEAUTY, and alone makes animated, united effort possible. These forces are within the reach of all men; and an association of men, actuated by them, ought to exercise an immense power in the world. If Masonry does not, it is because she has ceased to possess them." ¹

"Honor and Duty are the pole-stars of a Mason. ...So the Mason who loses sight of these is lost, and sinking out of sight, will disappear unhonored and unwept." ²

The formula in short:

- A) We have the will which is our dominant desire, created by our individual freedom of choice.
- B) We have the magnetic attraction of the heart towards truth and virtue.
- C) We have the three greatest moral forces of wisdom, strength and beauty.
- D) We have the direction in which to travel, the pole stars of honor and duty.

It seems that, according to Br. Pike, true Masons choose to follow their hearts toward truth and virtue, by striving to attain wisdom, strength and beauty as they follow the guidelines of honor and duty. Surely, in a world clouded and dimmed by human vices and vicissitudes, the Great Architect would smile on such brothers, knowing, beyond a doubt, that such striving leads to the highest quality of brotherly love.
