I would like to start by first THANKING YOU for the honor of electing me to the East as your Master for 2013. This is not something I take lightly and am proud to have your trust.

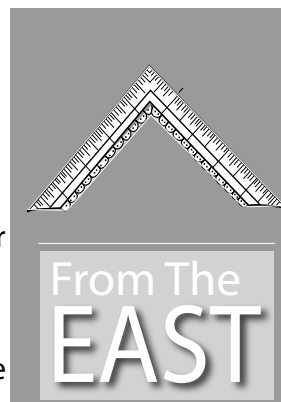

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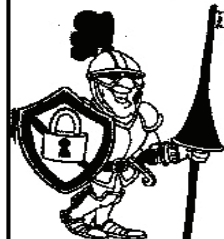
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Trowel-Talk #20 by Brother Tom Lyle, PVST29

Question: In what lies the beauty of a snowflake?

Answer: In the invisible hexagon.

My brothers, many of us have read that God geometrizes. In Chet Raymo's fascinating book Honey From Stone, he shares many lovely examples of this concept in his personal search for God as a Naturalist. The exoteric (outer) beauty as a geometric echo of the esoteric (inner) beauty is the story of the snowflake and its six fold symmetry.

It begins (its incipency) as a speck of dust, invisible to the eye, in a cloud, where the temperature has dropped to 14 degrees F. or 18 deg below freezing. The cloud's humidity (also invisible to the eye) now manifests as ice crystals on that speck of dust (don't ask me how), and invisibly begins to grow. The atomic structure of humidity (water, H₂O) is hexagonal, the six sided-ness of which carries through to the shape of the flake. (Don't ask me how).

So what, in the universe, does a snowflake have to do with brotherly love? No. This will not be a Masonic magic trick, where the rabbit pops out of the traditional top hat. It has to do with one way that Man learns – through correspondences. (Nope. Not pen pals). It is, perhaps, a calculated leap (inductive rather than deductive logic) to grasp greater understanding.

The invisible interaction of the speck of dust with its environment of invisible humidity and invisible temperature makes that speck of dust the center, or heart, of the snowflake, as it evolves its ephemeral (lasting but a brief moment of time) beauty, which melts on the tongues of children, and sometimes on the tongues of us young-old dudes. Some of us have even seen snowflakes instantly melt upon touching the streets of Phoenix.

In a most friendly exploration of the imagination, Man's physical incipency was, and is, the invisible interaction of two invisible cells (egg & sperm), the invisible growth of which is nurtured by an umbilical cord and a warm liquid in the womb, both invisible to the naked eye before birth. That embryo is dependent for growth upon invisible molecular structure, or cellular information, called DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid). Like the snowflake, the inner (esoteric) shapes the outer (exoteric).

Again with friendly imagination, the Mason (as a symbolic rough ashler) interacts with invisible concepts, such as wisdom, which invisibly nourish with the strength to smooth our ashler in order to create that beauty necessary for a greater invisible purpose, the service of brotherly love. The physical then, in time and mostly unseen, melts back into Nature as the non-physical invisibly progresses to a far greater service of brotherly love, truly invisible (esoteric) to the naked eye.

Now some may unhesitatingly say, "That's quite a tall tale -- an incredible stretch of the (invisible) imagination". Then again, my brothers, some will, with a joyful gleam in their eye, smilingly say, "That's Masonry". ☺
